Dress:

- Commencement is a formal academic event. Dress should be, at a minimum, **business casual** (collared shirt, slacks, dresses/skirts and comfortable walking shoes). Prepare to walk from Sandridge Student Center to the Gymnasium, which includes many stairs.
- The University recognizes the significance of academic achievement as well as the value of service in University recognized clubs and organizations. Students are encouraged to demonstrate these achievements through the wearing of official honor cords and stoles **that represent those accomplishments**.
- Caps may be tastefully decorated; there must not be decorative items hanging from the mortar board.

<u>Honors</u>

To be eligible for a degree with honors, an <u>undergraduate</u> student must have completed at least 45 undergraduate semester hours at the University. Honors does not apply to graduate degrees.

- Degrees with honor are based on performance in <u>all</u> undergraduate academic work completed at Athens State University, with the exception of any coursework excluded by course forgiveness or academic bankruptcy.
- The following honors may be awarded to undergraduate students:
 - Institutional GPA of 3.9 4.0
 - Institutional GPA of 3.70 3.89

Summa Cum Laude (gold medallion)

- 3.89 *Magna Cum Laude* (silver medallion)
- Institutional GPA of 3.50 -3.69
- .69 *Cum Laude* (bronze medallion)
- Since all grades for the final semester may not be available in time for commencement ceremonies and printing of commencement programs, degree with honor designations for a commencement ceremony are unofficial.
- Final academic honor designations are determined after grades for the final semester have been posted. Final, official honor designations will be reflected on the Athens State transcript and on the Athens State diploma.
