## **Eligibility**

## Ceremony

- Report to Lindsay Lane Baptist Church, Educational Building A at 12:00 p.m.
   (You will enter the property parking lot off of Pepper Rd., following "Graduate Entrance and Parking".)
- Tickets are not required for the ceremony, and there is no limit to the number of guests invited.

#### Dress:

- Commencement is a formal academic event. Dress should be, at a minimum, business casual (collared shirt, slacks, dresses/skirts and comfortable walking shoes). Prepare to walk from Educational Building A to the church building, which will involve a series of stairs.
- The University recognizes the significance of academic achievement as well as the value of service in university recognized clubs and organizations. Students are encouraged to demonstrate these achievements through the wearing of official honor cords and stoles that represent those accomplishments.
- Caps may be tastefully decorated; there must not be decorative items hanging from the mortar board.

### Honors

# Honors does not apply to graduate degrees.

- To be eligible for a degree with honors, a student must have completed at least 31
  undergraduate semester hours at the University, not including coursework excluded by course
  forgiveness or academic bankruptcy.
- The following honors may be awarded to undergraduate students:

Institutional GPA of 3.9 - 4.0
 Summa Cum Laude (gold medallion)

■ Institutional GPA of 3.70 - 3.89 *Magna Cum Laude* (silver medallion)

Institutional GPA of 3.50 -3.69
 Cum Laude (bronze medallion)

- Since all grades for the final semester may not be available in time for commencement ceremonies and printing of commencement programs, degree with honor designations for a commencement ceremony are unofficial.
- Final academic honor designations are determined after grades for the final semester have been posted. Final, official honor designations will be reflected on the Athens State transcript and on the Athens State diploma.
- Honors medallions are available for purchase in the University Spirit Store, located in the basement of Sandridge Student Center. They will also be available at Lindsay Lane Baptist Church on the day of Commencement. The cost is \$20 (tax not included).

# **Diplomas and Transcripts**

- Diplomas will be sent electronically and mailed to all graduates by January 16, 2026. None will be given at the ceremony.
- Transcripts
  - should be used to provide employers with proof of graduation.
  - graduation information should be posted on the transcripts by the Records Office a day or two after grades are due (December 9, 2025).
