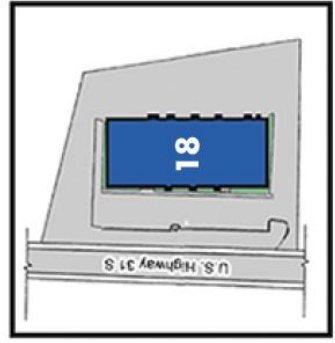




# Campus Map
