

## **CRRSAA – INSTITUTIONAL FUNDS**

- The Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA)(P.L. 116-260) was signed by the President on December 27, 2020. The funds that Athens State University received from the Department of Education for the Institutional Portion defined in Section 314(a)(1) of CRRSAA totaled \$1,648,235 and are a supplemental award to the existing Institutional Aid Portion (CFDA 84.425F).
- Allowable uses under the CRRSAA for Institutional Portion awards included expenses associated with coronavirus such as lost revenue, technology costs associated with distance learning, faculty and staff training and additional financial aid grants to students.
- \$59,909.00 of the Institutional Portion received was spent on additional Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students on March 5, 2021, as allowed under Section 314(a)(1).
- Lost revenue totaled \$623,886.00 for 2020 fall semester and \$481,040.00 for 2021 spring semester.

A total of \$1,104,926.00 has been used to offset lost revenue. The lost revenue calculation was based on CRRSAA guidance by using a semester-over-semester comparison to the prior year.

- An additional \$333,727.88 was used for technology resources for distance learning and coronavirus prevention programs. The remaining amount of \$149,672.12 will be spent on technology resources and lost revenue.
- The remaining portion of \$149,672.12 was spent on lost revenue in May 2021. The initial funding was fully expended as of June 30, 2021.
- \$149,672 was spent on lost revenue on June 4, 2021. All funds were expended as of September 30, 2021.
