Some of the majors are especially able to assist you with your **CS 305/317/318/372** course needs. There are some upper level courses for which assistance can be sought, but contact the MCNS Lab or visit the MCNS Lab Website for specific time slots for programming help. Although MNCS Learning Lab employees <u>CANNOT</u> assist with completion of graded assessments, quizzes or tests, they <u>CAN</u> provide tutoring in specific topics.

Current ASU MCNS Learning Lab key notes:

- We have traditional face-to-face on-campus tutoring available at the MCNS Learning Lab facilities in Waters Room S-202 and remote tutoring services available.
- ∞ Evening hours are generally available Monday through Thursday, but exceptions occur depending upon staff availability.
