Updates for Fall 2019

Changes to Marketing Minor & Certificate & Small Business Entrepreneurship Minor (2019-2020):

MK 333 Advertising, MK 336 Consumer Behavior, and MK 432 Retailing have been removed from the Fall 2019 Catalog and will no longer be taught. For students in the marketing minor, MK 335 Integrated Marketing Communications will take the place of MK 333; MK 337 Digital Marketing will take the place of MK 336; and MK 434 Sales Management will take the place of MK 432. In the certificate, MK 335 will take the place of MK 336, and MK 337 will take the place of MK 432. For students in the Small Business/ Entrepreneurship Minor, replace MK 432 with MK 335. Please consult your advisor if you have any questions. Depending on your Catalog year, your advisor may need to submit a curriculum adjustment form for these new courses to populate correctly in Degree Works.

Addition/Change to Certificate Programs:

A Certificate in Cybersecurity Operations will be available this fall. See online Catalog for more details or contact Darren Waldrep at Darren.Waldrep@athens.edu or 256-216-5366. Degree-seeking students who wish to apply for certificate completion and have the certificate noted on the official transcript must add the certificate as a concurrent goal. Students can do this in Athens State Online using the Request for Change of Program form. Once the certificate is declared as a goal, students will be able to apply for completion of the certificate using Athens State Online. Degree-seeking students may apply for certificate completion, even if their degree completion is several semesters away. Certificate only (non-degree seeking) students will apply for certificate completion using the same method. The URL is http://www.athens.edu/commencement/apply/. No fee is charged for the application for completion of a certificate only; students applying for graduation in a degree program are charged a graduation fee. Change to Masters Program in GLSCM:

It is now possible to finish an online graduate program in Global Logistics & Supply Chain Management in only 12 months (3 semesters). This new cohort option begins with the Fall 2019 semester. Students will complete courses in a concentrated 1st half and 2nd half terms in both fall and spring (4 courses per semester), and a full 10-week term in the summer (2 courses). DID YOU KNOW:

A 2-year scheduling plan is published to our website every year. The schedule is sorted by subject headings of courses and tells you when and how a course is planned to be offered.
