A big thank you to Professor Emeritus Linda Hemingway for her financial support for our students to attend the conference this year in her favorite city! Go Steelers!






New Member Orientation

"We welcomed Rich Wilkinson, Senior Director of Industry Marketing at Unanet as our guest speaker on October 13th. Rich gave many exciting details on the GAUGE survey and report. The government contracting-specific survey helps provide a future look at firms' activities and work characteristics. It investigates competitiveness, the business environment, and how the pandemic has affected productivity. It also addresses the type of audits and audit challenges a company has. The survey asks questions about what issues a company has faced, such as recruiting. The GAUGE survey and report takes six months and had 1,170 respondents from companies of all shapes and sizes. 35 students attended this meeting." - Kaitlyn Johnson
