BECKER - CPA REVIEW

On November 4th, Ashley Stephens spoke to the Accounting Club about Becker material. To become a Certified Public Accountant, there are five steps. Step 1: meet the educational requirements. Step 2: apply to take the exam. Step 3: study for the exam. Step 4: schedule the exam. Step 5: succeed. After an individual passes the exam, they can apply for licensure. Students learned the options for transferring a CPA license across states. Ashley showed students the NASBA website; this website shows what the educational requirements are for each state to sit for the CPA exam. The application to sit for the exam can be found as well on the Alabama State Board of Public Accounting. She also showed students the Prometric website; this website shows students where CPA testing centers are. In the state of Alabama, students will need to have 150 credit hours of schooling. Also, to sit for the exam, students will need at least one year of work experience related to the accounting field. She also went over the CMA and the importance of CMAs. Overall, Ashley's

presentation was very informative

On October 28th 2021 the Accounting Club had the privilege to tour NDesigns in Fayetteville, Tennessee. I will never view a screen printed shirt the same way! This business designs and makes custom shirts, hats, purses, wallets, and even leather mouse pads! They also do embroidery, digital media, and boat wrapping. The company began in 1996 and the owner said he still has his first ever screen printing machine to remember how far he has come. We discussed the benefits of making their own screens to print shirts and the process to remove the ink as to not waste a drop. We also got to see the whole process of screen printing a T-shirt. The process includes: creating the design, making the screen, setting the machine to press the color, curing the shirts, counting the order, and finally folding the shirts to box. We saw and discussed their inventory process and how the pandemic has caused it to change. The tour was incredibly interesting. As accountants we have more to think about than just numbers and general ledgers and industry tours such as these really bring the accounting world full circle.
