New Graduate Program (Fall 2022):

MAcc Master of Accountancy

The Master of Accountancy (MAcc) program will provide students with advanced knowledge and a diverse set of skills in current, developing, and emergence accounting topics. The program will help accelerate students' careers and prepare them to pursue leadership positions in public accounting, industry, government, and not-for-profit organizations. The MAcc helps prepare students for the Uniform Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Examination and to meet the 150-credit hour requirement for CPA certification in Alabama and many other states. It also provides a solid foundation to pursue other professional accounting certifications, such as the Certified Management Accountant (CMA) credential. New Undergraduate Program (Fall 2022)

B.S. Aerospace Systems Management

A major in Aerospace Systems Management has two areas of possible concentration: Aviation and Space Systems. Aviation is designed for those students pursuing a commercial pilot or aircraft mechanic career path. Space Systems is for those students aiming at a management career in space exploration. Typical occupations where this major could apply are commercial airline pilot; airport manager; aviation maintenance manager; space mission planning, control, and communications; aerospace project management; aircraft/aerospace manufacturing manager/supervisor; and avionics and aircraft/spacecraft systems. **Contact: Dr. Wayne McCain (Wayne.McCain@athens.edu)**

New Certificates (2021-2022):

Advanced Manufacturing Management (Undergraduate)

This certificate has four required courses: LSM 330, MG 392, AMM 400, and MG 430, as well as one additional course from AMM 301, AMM 302, MG 320, MG 349, MG 390, and MG 421.

Forensic Accounting (Undergraduate)

This certificate has four required courses: AC 312, AC 442, AC 451, and AC 452, as well as one additional course from AC 362, AC 431, AC 435, AC 441, GBA 314, and MCO 409.

Occupational Health and Safety Management (Undergraduate)

Required courses for this certificate are MG 346, MG 390, OHSM 300, and OHSM 385. Students will choose one additional course from the following: OHSM 350, OHSM 391, or OHSM 425.

Accountancy (Graduate)

Choose five of the following courses: ACC 511, ACC 512, ACC 525, ACC 540, ACC 551, ACC 552, ACC 561, ACC 571, ACC 620, ACC 630, ACC 640, ACC 650, ACC 660, ACC 670.

A grade of "C" or better must be achieved on all courses in a certificate; please consult course descriptions for possible prerequisites.
