Provisional Certificate in a Teaching Field (PCTF) Enrollment Guide
(previously called ABC)


According to the Alabama State Department of Education, the Provisional Certificate in a Teaching Field approach is for specific **K-12 and 6-12 teaching fields**. Certification based on the PCTF approach may **ONLY** be requested by an employing Alabama county/city superintendent or eligible non-public school administrator. An individual should contact the school system or eligible non-public school in which employment is desired for information concerning certificate eligibility.

Applicants must hold a bachelor's or higher degree with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.

Certification based on this approach consists of **3 levels** (First, Second, Third). NOTE: Effective AY1920, the Educative Teacher Performan Assessment (edTPA) will be required. Training will be offered by the employing LEA.
