New Business: Dr. Ron Cromwell, Provost, was guest speaker. He addressed the issues which he is working on at the moment: 1) Data, 2) Centers, 3) Provost's Authority, 4) QEP, and 5) DL Policies. He emphasized that that which he is working on is not necessarily what he thinks most important, rather what demanded his attention first. He would like to see workloads reasonable to enhance student learning, see centers defined, see strategic planning enrich student lives, see the QEP "owned at the deepest level and embraced wholeheartedly, not adhered to in fear of SACS." He admitted that right now the "stumbling blocks have obscured his view of quality," but that all he has is a "snapshot," and that it will "really take about four semesters" to get the big picture. Senators thanked him for coming.
