Pf.T. (Philosophical Foundations and Technology) department from the College of Education proposed the following:

- ED 303: Practicum in Teacher Education – 1 hour new course
- ED 406: Computers for Teacher Productivity – Change title and description
- ED 302: Foundations of Education – remove prerequisite
- All Educational Technology minor courses – remove prerequisites and change course description statement to include: “This course requires an intermediate-level technology/computer skill such as proficiency with using word processing, email, slide presentations, and basic video production. This is not a beginning-level technology course.”
- ED 420: Strategies for Gifted and Talented Students – 3 hour new course
