 - (4) Must demonstrate financial need
 - (5) Must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA
 - (6) All recipients must be residents of and graduate from a high school in Franklin, Morgan, Colbert, Lawrence, Limestone, or Lauderdale counties in the State of Alabama.
 - (7) All recipients must be first-generation college students (neither parents nor grandparents graduated from college).
 - (8) Each recipient will receive a maximum of \$2,500.00 each academic semester for a maximum of \$5,000.00 for an academic year, contingent on available funding. Scholarship funds may be applied towards tuition, books, or fees. An academic semester will be defined as either a fall semester or a spring semester.
 - (9) All recipients must pass a minimum of twenty-one semester hours in an academic year in order to receive the scholarship for the next academic year. Given that the scholarship requires a minimum of nine hours per semester and twenty-one semester hours in an academic year, recipients must take an additional course at some point during the academic year in order to receive the scholarship in subsequent years. Depending on the type of coursework taken and the cost of books or other fees, this may require some out-of-pocket expense for the recipient.
 - (10) Each recipient may continue to receive the scholarship as long as the criteria are met with the following restrictions: A recipient classified as a junior may receive the award for a maximum of six semesters. A recipient classified as a senior may receive the award for a maximum of three semesters. All awards will be based on the recipient meeting all of the criteria.
