

### Eligibility

If you have questions about your eligibility to graduate, **REVIEW YOUR DEGREE WORKS PLAN OF STUDY AND CONSULT WITH YOUR ADVISOR.**

### Ceremony

- Report to the Sandridge Student Center Ballroom at 8:00 a.m. for line-up and instructions. You will have your temperature screened before entering the Ballroom.
- Tickets are not required for the ceremony, and there is no limit to the number of guests invited. Guests will have their temperatures screened before entering Carter Gym.
- Graduation supplies are available at the University Bookstore, and can be purchased anytime between now and December 4, 2021.
  - The prices (not including tax) are listed below:

▪ Undergraduate	cap/gown/tassel	\$43.75
▪ Masters	cap/gown/tassel/hood	\$84.75

### Dress:

- Men – wear a collared shirt, slacks and comfortable shoes
- Women – wear slacks, dresses/skirts and comfortable, **low-heeled shoes\***  
\*recently, we have had instances in which graduates have fallen due to the style and height of their footwear

### Honors

**To be eligible for a degree with honors, a student must have completed at least 45 undergraduate semester hours at the University.**

- Degrees with honor are based on performance in all undergraduate academic work completed at Athens State University, with the exception of any coursework excluded by course forgiveness or academic bankruptcy.
- The following honors may be awarded to undergraduate students:
  - Institutional GPA of 3.9 - 4.0 *Summa Cum Laude* (gold medallion)
  - Institutional GPA of 3.70 - 3.89 *Magna Cum Laude* (silver medallion)
  - Institutional GPA of 3.50 -3.69 *Cum Laude* (bronze medallion)
- Since all grades for the final semester may not be available in time for commencement ceremonies and printing of commencement programs, degree with honor designations for a commencement ceremony are unofficial.
- Final academic honor designations are determined after grades for the final semester have been posted. Final, official honor designations will be reflected on the Athens State transcript and on the Athens State diploma.

## Diplomas and Transcripts
