
# Athens-State Healthcheck A COVID-19 Assessment Tool





# ATHENS-STATE HEALTHCHECK REQUIREMENT



Before returning to campus, all students, faculty and staff must complete Athens-State Healthcheck, a web-based COVID-19 assessment tool that evaluates existence of any current COVID-19-related symptoms, exposure history, and testing history.



We encourage you to complete Athens-State Healthcheck **daily**. You are required to complete it **every three days**, and you can opt-in to get a reminder.

(A "pass" through the Athens-State Passport is only valid for 24 hours, so if you work on campus or visit on a daily basis, the Athens-State Healthcheck must be completed daily.)

If you have new COVID-19 symptoms or exposure, report it immediately in Athens-State Healthcheck.

### **SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19**

Students, faculty, and staff must be free of all symptoms **potentially related to COVID-19** to return to campus. As you evaluate your symptoms, **only report new symptoms that are not related to existing health conditions** (i.e. seasonal allergies) or recent activity (i.e. soreness, difficulty breathing, etc.). As of July 6, 2020, these symptoms include one or more of the following:

Cough

Headache

Shortness of breath

Fever

Sore throat

Nausea or vomiting

Diarrhea

Muscle aches

New loss of taste or smell









#### ATHENS-STATE HEALTHCHECK DAILY CHECK-IN



The initial Healthcheck survey takes 20 seconds to complete.



Subsequent survey takes 10 seconds to complete.




Upon completion, you are assigned a risk category with actionable items.

- If you have participated in a public COVID-19 assessment tool, you are still required to participate in Athens-State Healthcheck.
- Athens-State Healthcheck is specifically for re-entry to our campus.
- ► Athens-State Healthcheck will help us all return to campus safely and avoid further risk and exposure to COVID-19.



# Stay Safe & Healthy!

It is recommended to report symptoms and exposure on a daily basis, but it is required to do so every three days.

#### **APPENDIX**

#### Athens-State Healthcheck Attestation

I acknowledge and agree that one of the requirements I must satisfy to be eligible to return to campus is to complete the Athens-State Healthcheck located at <a href="www.athens.edu/healthcheck">www.athens.edu/healthcheck</a> to evaluate whether I am currently experiencing COVID-19-related symptoms, been exposed to COVID-19, and/or whether I have been tested for COVID-19. I further acknowledge and agree that after I return to campus, I am responsible for continuing to complete health screening updates related to COVID-19 through <a href="www.athens.edu/healthcheck">www.athens.edu/healthcheck</a> on a regular basis (at least every three (3) days) and that if I fail to do so, I will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to revocation of my clearance to return to campus, written counseling, and/or termination of employment. I understand that I may choose to receive text messages from <a href="www.athens.edu/healthcheck">www.athens.edu/healthcheck</a> reminding me to complete the regular health screening updates, but that if I opt out from receiving such text messages, I am still responsible for completing the health screening updates as described above.
