## MINUTES Budget Advisory Committee April 13, 2017, 1:30 p.m.

Mr. McCoy presented a handout summarizing requested funds for operating budgets, critical needs, and personnel requests that are over the 2016-17 approved budget. The total amount of additional requests is \$1,358,842. Before the budget hearings began, Mr. McCoy was projecting a beginning deficit of \$602,219. The total for both of these amounts is \$1,961,061. A tuition increase of 3.5% would generate \$653,961 in revenue and decrease the deficit to \$1,307,200. Mr. McCoy mentioned that a reduction in the University's transfer to plant/reserves was another option for balancing the budget. The committee agreed and a reduction to plant/reserves combined with the 3.5% tuition increase was used to fund the following list of increases recommended by the committee and balance the budget.

- College of Arts & Sciences \$17,615 critical needs and \$8645 increased operating budget
- College of Business \$18,000 critical needs and \$8645 increased operating budget
- College of Education \$15,000 critical needs and \$8645 increased operating budget
- Completion College \$43,000 operating budget and \$133,416 new personnel salary and benefits
- Academic Technology \$35,567 increased operating budget
- Technology Services \$20,000 critical needs and \$3490 increased operating budget (additional possible savings of \$80,057 for Blackboard contract)
- Library \$22,850 critical needs and \$29,455 increased operating budget
- Testing Center \$5500 critical needs and \$3275 increased operating budget
- SACS \$1100 increased operating budget
- Faculty Professional Development \$3000 increased operating budget
- Academic Affairs \$2900 increased operating budget
- Enrollment/Student Services \$112,200 critical needs
- Operational Technology \$177,000 critical needs and \$37,689 increased operating budget
- University Advancement \$4300 increased operating budget
- Development & Alumni \$49,500 increased operating budget
- Marketing & PR \$6500 increased operating budget
- Human Resources \$10,600 increased operating budget
- Board of Trustees \$7950 operating budget
- Alabama Ctr. for Arts \$30,000 increased operating budget
- University Centers \$32,400 operating budget

Mr. McCoy and Mr. Craft will work to summarize these changes and prepare the recommendation for the President's Cabinet for the May 15<sup>th</sup> meeting. Mr. McCoy expects the Executive Committee of the Board to address the tuition rate at the beginning of June.
