

## **BUDGET YEAR 2018-2019**

Dr. Quinnell requested \$282,745 for the library operations budget, up from \$240,845 the previous year. She is requesting and increase in out of state travel to provide an extra \$500 for each librarian. She has also factored in a 4% increase for subscription costs. This is the expected rate of inflation for subscriptions each year. She has also requested a \$30,000 increase for books. This is for multi-user license ebooks. The demand for the ebooks is significantly increasing.

The critical needs for the Library and Archives, totaling \$20,000, include:

- Adding to the collection of Career Tech resources to support the new graduate program \$5000
- Binding of loose periodicals \$10,000
- Redesign and remodel of reference/circulation desk area \$10,000

Dr. Quinnell presented a personnel request for three new positions.

- Open Educational Resources Librarian projected salary of \$59,015
- Library Support Specialist for Archives projected salary of \$30,626
- Library Support Specialist for Collections projected salary of \$32,067

Dr. Quinnell also requested \$4,525 for the Library Archives budget, up from \$3,400 the previous year. The line items increased are out of state travel, membership cost for the Alabama Digital Preservation Network, and technology for mobile less-invasive scanners to digitize fragile materials.
