Dr. Delap is requesting \$20,850 for the operational budget for Academic Affairs. This is up from \$16,850. The increase is to cover additional travel for Dr. Delap, and Associate VP Dr. Jackie Smith and Assistant VP Dr. Ronnie Merritt. Also, he has included the cost for membership fees for NC-Sara and ACHE.

Dr. Delap next presented the request for Faculty Professional Development. He is requesting \$41,600. This is up from \$28,000. The increases are for subscriptions for Institutional Review Board, contractual services for American Council for Undergraduate Education, and materials for a mentoring conference.

Finally, Dr. Delap presented the budget request for the Completion College Initiative. He is requesting \$43,000, which is a level funding request.
