Due to the campus closure related to COVID-19, members of the Budget Advisory Committee participated in this meeting by means of electronic communications (through a telephone/Zoom conference call).

Mr. Warren is requesting \$488,600 for the physical plant budget. This is a decrease from last year's budget of \$590,260. This budget includes mostly repairs, supplies and outside contractor agreements. Previously, this budget has included the expense of the outside custodial contractor. This year, he has moved custodial expense to a separate budget. This is a factor in the decreased physical plant budget. The budget for custodial services is \$280,000. These two budgets combined total \$768,600

Mr. Warren next presented the physical security systems budget. This budget includes the following areas: fire alarms, camera surveillance, and access control. Mr. Warren is requesting \$92,000 for this budget. This is an increase from \$73,000 last year.
