Dr. Smith is requesting \$22,475 for the operational budget for Academic Affairs. This is up from \$20,850. The increase is to cover additional cost of copier rental, memberships, printing and computer software.

Dr. Smith next presented the request for Faculty Professional Development. She is requesting \$30,150. This is down from \$30,800.

Finally, Dr. Smith presented the budget request for the Completion College Initiative. She is requesting \$35,000. This is a decrease from \$43,000.
