Mr. Guenther presented the operational budget request for \$42,848. This is an increase from \$40,985. He pointed out that the cost of the University-wide assessment software is now allocated to this budget rather than the general administrative budget. This expense represents \$35,517 of his request. The majority of the other budget line items are unchanged with the exception of an increase for the copier rental/usage due to increased printing requirements for Administrative Council and the Strategic Planning Committee.

Mr. Guenther presented a personnel request for a data scientist. Based on CUPA research, he is projecting a salary of \$54,868. He indicated the purpose of the request is to support increasing requests for information being submitted and to support new Horizon 2030 Strategic Plan initiatives.
