

Course Delivery Types: How to Read in Degree Works

There are three types of delivery methods at Athens State: On-Campus/Traditional, 100% Online/Distance Learning, and Blended.

You can use your Degree Works¹ to configure your upcoming courses. When you click on a hyperlinked "**Still Needed**" course in your Degree Works, a pop-up provides the course description, its availability in the upcoming semester(s), and its delivery methods.

The detailed online Academic Schedule² can also be used to verify course formats, day/time, location, and instructor. After you register for a course, the course details can be found in your detailed schedule through your Banner Self Service in myAthens Portal³.

On-Campus/Traditional

- Taught weekly on a specific day and time in the traditional classroom setting.
- Class is listed with a day or days of the week and times for meetings.
- Depending on the major, some classrooms will be in a different location other than the Athens State Main Campus. Be sure to confirm your location on the Academic Schedule⁴.

100% Online/Distance Learning

- Taught 100% online using Blackboard with no oncampus requirement.
- Class is listed with only "TBA" for the date and/or time.

Blended/Hybrid

- Class is delivered online and also has specific oncampus/on-location requirements.
- Class is listed with a combination of "TBA" and specified dates and times.

(Lab fee) (Prerequisite: At least one college-level mathematics course) (Fulfills General Education Area III Mathematics). (Cannot be used to satisfy requirement for upper-level mathematics elective for mathematics majors or other scientific majors.) This course helps students to develop greater mathematical skills and insight. It also introduces students to topics in numeration systems, elementary number theory, problem solving, introduction to probability theory, statistics, and geometry.
