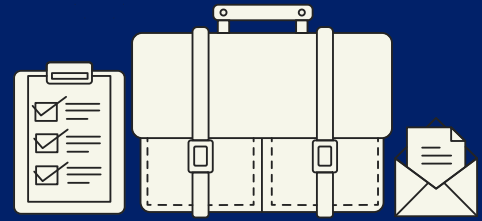

The myAthens Portal will be your hub. It is found on the main university homepage at www.athens.edu. You need your temporary password and student email from your acceptance letter to log in for the first time. In the portal you access and manage many aspects of your student affairs including:

- Accessing the MyAthens Self Service where you will register for classes, pay tuition and fees, update your contacts, review and accept financial aid, among other items.
- Accessing Degree Works, Canvas, Navigate, important messages, among others items.

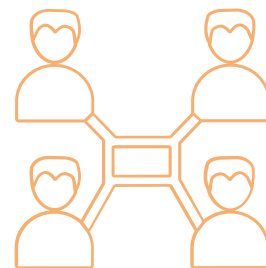
